Concertgoers can save with buy one, get one free companion fares on travel to Orange County's newest concert venue for 2017 season shows on October 5 - 7

Amtrak will offer special late-night northbound Pacific Surfliner service to Los Angeles and north Orange County after each concert, including Young the Giant (October 5), Fish Family Night (October 6), and Jack's 12th Show (October 7). Concerts end at 11 p.m.

The special northbound return train (597) will depart Irvine promptly at 11:40 p.m. A southbound Pacific Surfliner train (796) will depart Irvine at 11:09 p.m. Concert attendees can take any Pacific Surfliner train to the FivePoint Amphitheatre with service from San Diego, Oceanside, Anaheim, Los Angeles and intermediate stops.
